

JET AGE MUSEUM OPENING TO THE PUBLIC – QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q. Why aren't the Trident and Vulcan open cockpits available for visitors to sit in yet?

A. The public space in the Trident and Vulcan is very limited and we need to be sure that the ventilation provided in both is sufficient to ensure that risks of COVID transmission to our volunteers and visitors are minimised. It is not clear yet when these cockpits will re-open but please keep an eye on the website or social media for updates.

Q. Will you be opening in the school holidays and on bank holidays as you did before the pandemic?

A. We will not be opening on Wednesdays in the Gloucestershire school holidays or on bank holidays until further notice. We need to rebuild our volunteer guide and duty manager numbers to be able to guarantee opening on these dates in future.

Q. Can I book a private adult or youth group visit yet?

A. Unfortunately, it will not be possible to book a private group visit until further notice. We will publicise the re-opening of our booking system as soon as we can.

Q. Can I book a school or education visit yet?

A. Not yet. The volunteer education team needs some time to prepare for school visits to the Museum. If your school has not visited us before, please e-mail contact@jetagemuseum.org to be added to our list for future visits.
